



Female Hockey Registration Process

This document should provide details on registering for female hockey at the Novice, Atom, Peewee, Bantam (including AA) and Midget (including AA) age groups. It should also clarify the requirements depending on where you live in St. Boniface and Transcona.

If you are in the catchment area for Winakwa, Southdale, Norwood, Archwood, Champlain or Notre Dame, you are considered part of St. Boniface.

Regardless of your residency in St. Boniface, you must purchase a community/ membership card from your community centre. This card can be purchased during your community's fall registration period. This is required for all female hockey programs including AA. It will be asked for during the registration process.

For Transcona residents, you must first register at your community centre. Please see additional details below.

For St. Boniface female hockey registration:

- We do not offer on-line registrations.
- We do not offer any transfers from boys hockey or ringette. These are separate initiatives and as such, we do not have agreements on fund transfers.
- You must pay by cheque or cash (no debit, visa or other credit cards)

Southdale Registrations

For Southdale residents, please obtain your community card during your community's fall registration period.

You can register at the Southdale Community Centre on the following dates:

- Thursday, September 2, 6:30 to 8:00
- Thursday, September 9, 6:30 to 8:00
- Saturday, September 11, 10:00 to 2:00

Winakwa/ Norwood/ Archwood/ Champlain/ Notre Dame Registrations

For those areas other than Southdale, please obtain your community card during your community's fall registration period before registering for female hockey.

The St. Boniface female hockey registration is based at Southdale. We do not offer female hockey registrations at these community centres. Unfortunately, many of the community centres have fall registration at the same time making it difficult to be in all places.

You can register at the Southdale Community Centre on the following dates:

- Thursday, September 2, 6:30 to 8:00
- Thursday, September 9, 6:30 to 8:00
- Saturday, September 11, 10:00 to 2:00

Transcona Registrations

Transcona players must first register out of Transcona. Similar to the St. Boniface process, Transcona players must purchase a community/ membership card from their community centre. This card can be purchased during your community's fall registration period.

Players must first register out of Transcona because the players reside in Transcona. This is an established process supported by Winnipeg Minor Hockey (Winnipeg Female Council), St. Boniface Female Hockey and Transcona Female Hockey.

As in past years, Transcona Female Hockey will provide information to registered players on the Four on Four camps and evaluations during registration.

After the registration period, Transcona Female Hockey will provide the registered names to St. Boniface Female Hockey.

If any applicable fees are collected by Transcona Female Hockey, the amounts will be passed to St. Boniface Female Hockey and applied against the cost of registration.

Prior to the evaluations, Transcona residents will be required to complete a St. Boniface registration form.

Provided your player has registered with Transcona, you may:

- Attend the Southdale registration and complete the required forms and payment
- Make arrangements with the convener to complete the form and make payment

Midget AA & Bantam AA

In-person registration for the AA programs is mandatory (St. Boniface and Transcona players). Although you must complete the residency requirements (listed above), your player must register for the AA program at Southdale Community Centre on the following dates:

- Thursday, September 2, 6:30 to 8:00
- Thursday, September 9, 6:30 to 8:00
- Saturday, September 11, 10:00 to 2:00

Please note that there will be an evaluation fee for the AA program try-outs. This is separate and above any registration fees collected during registration.
